

## **The catalog of Confiscated Assets is published, a step forward in increasing transparency**

The Agency for the Administration of Sequestered and Confiscated Assets (AAPSK) has published for the first time a catalogue of confiscated assets, taking an important step towards increasing transparency and accountability. This catalogue contains a detailed list of assets confiscated by final court decision, including full information on their type, location and current status.

The catalogue has been published in accordance with the applicable legal framework, in particular based on Law No. 34/2019 “On the Administration of Sequestered and Confiscated Assets”, which sets out the rules and procedures for the sequestration, confiscation and administration of illegally acquired assets.

The main purpose of this publication is to ensure full and clear information to the public and interested parties, strengthening trust and integrity in the process of administering confiscated assets.

The initiative for the compilation and publication of the catalogue was taken by the Chief Administrator of the AAPSK, Ms. Risena Xhaja, who, upon her appointment to office in October 2024, established the working group and ordered the production of the catalogue, which aims to increase transparency and public access to information on confiscated assets; improve accountability in the process of administering and using these assets; and promote cooperation and trust between institutions and citizens.

The AAPSK is also in the process of compiling and publishing the catalogue of seized assets, while it is carrying out a complete inventory of the entire database of assets under administration, with the aim of further increasing transparency, efficiency and good administration of these assets.

The catalog of confiscated assets is available to the public on the Agency's official website and will be updated periodically to reflect changes and new developments.
